### **ASAP Club**

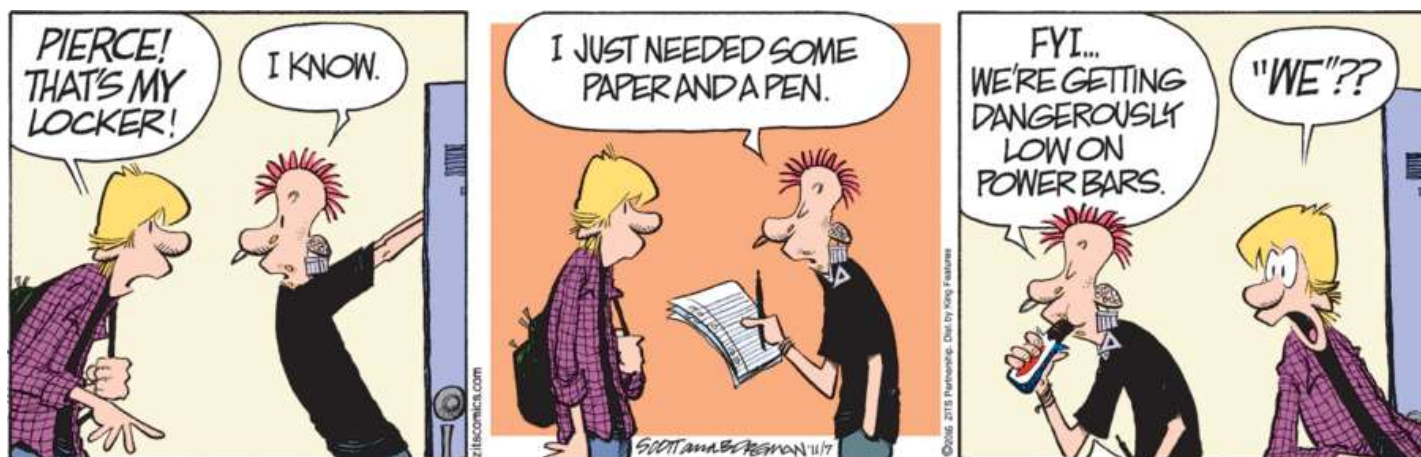
ASAP will meet every Thursday after school in Ms. Grimes office. Please see her if you have questions.
