### Paid Summer Internship for Life Sciences

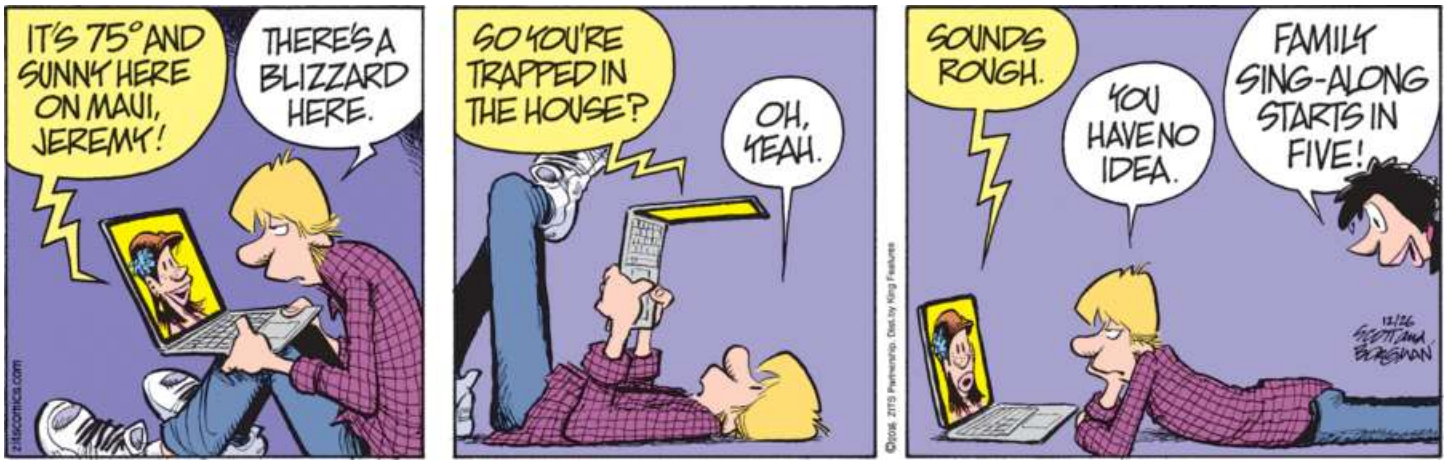
